INFORMATION REQUESTED

On April 12th 2014, a 15 foot Boston Whaler washed ashore at Sunset Beach in False Creek, Vancouver. At the time, the area was receiving 20-25 knot north westerly winds. The vessel appears to have been being used to salvage copper pipe and wire. A Stihl chainsaw was also located on the vessel. The vessel was equipped with an older Johnson 60 hp outboard and a Mercury 9.9 hp outboard. Both engines were located mounted to the transom with their cowlings removed. It appeared parts were being swapped between the engines. The information associated to vessel license 13K73560 does not appear to be current. All lines were secured on the vessel, showing no sign of the vessel breaking free from or being untied from its mooring.
