RECOVERED VESSEL

On August 1st at approximately 8:30 pm, people on Kitsilano Beach contacted the Vancouver Police to report a white and green 23 foot Bayliner Capri that had drifted onto the beach from approximately ½ mile off shore. Due to the engine being hot and the keys in the ignition with no one on board, Canadian Coast Guard crews from Kitsilano and Sea Island bases performed an extensive area search for possible bodies in the water. Vancouver Police Marine Unit members were able to identify the vessel as being stolen from a wharf in the Belcarra area of Burrard Inlet between July 31st and August 1st.
