On May 24th 2011 a Maxxon Inflatable was left tied to a vessel in the False Creek Harbour Authority docks near the Burrard Bridge. The owner of the vessel that it was tied on to, awoke to find his Brigg inflatable stolen and the Maxxon left in its place. The owner of the missing Brigg searched False Creek and subsequently found his vessel tied up at Stamps Landing in the False Creek east basin. His 2006 15 hp Mercury outboard is still outstanding.
